Bawah Reserve is a boutique resort consisting of six pristine islands surrounded by spectacular underwater scenery. We have access to 13 dive sites, located a short boat-ride away. We offer easy, relaxing diving, with vibrant shallow reefs and gentle currents.

As part of the 2nd largest Marine Protected Area (MPA) in Indonesia, Bawah features an abundance of flourishing coral reefs with vibrant marine life. We are proud to be part of the World Wildlife Fund's (WWF) Signing Blue Initiative, and our surrounding lagoons and reefs are marine conservation areas certified by WWF Indonesia.

We are a PADI-certified five-star diving centre with 4 marine biologists on staff. Safety is always our first priority and we operate at a maximum diver to guide ratio of 2:1. We have vibrant, gentle reefs for diving, and a sheltered, sandy lagoon perfect for training. Our mission is to help children and adults fall in love with the ocean and the marine life in it.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Our dive sites are home to colourful coral reefs with a wide variety of fish, invertebrates and other marine animals, starting around 2 – 3m deep and slowly sloping down to between 8 – 12m, before dropping off a steep shelf and levelling off again around at a depth of 25 – 30m. We use Scubapro diving equipment and offer flexible diving schedules that help you make the most of your underwater experiences. All of the dive sites around Bawah are within a 15-minute boat journey from the resort.

Fees for all dives and diving experiences include a donation and a marine park fee that goes towards the upkeep of the Anambas Marine Protected Area, or MPA.

The **PADI Bubblemaker Experience** is a fantastic way to introduce children between **8 - 10 years of age** to basic scuba diving skills.

It starts with a safety and theory briefing, where the students learn to stay close to their instructors and what to do if they start to feel nervous or get water in their masks.

Once they are comfortable with this, we show them how to operate their equipment, put it on and then - after practising some simple skills in our swimming pool - enter the safe, shallow reefs of our lagoon for a fun dive to a maximum depth of four metres.

If they enjoy the experience and are comfortable, we can then take them on additional fun dives from our custom dive boat on the outer reefs, again to a maximum depth of four metres. These additional dives are at a reduced cost compared to the initial Bubble Maker.

Once the student has completed their Bubble Maker, they will receive a Certificate of Recognition of their achievement.

To ensure the highest standard of safety, each Bawah Reserve diving instructor teaches no more than two students at a time.

PADI Discover Scuba Diving (DSD) is your first step beneath the surface.

This scuba diving experience provides a taster before committing to a full diving course. It includes introductory theory training plus skills practice in our swimming pool to teach the basics of diving. Your Bawah Reserve Dive Professional will cover all aspects of safety - both above and below the water - and teach you how to use the equipment correctly.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR DIVE EXPERIENCE

You'll learn essential scuba skills such as how to clear water from your regulator and mask, control your buoyancy, and swim comfortably underwater. The focus of this experience is on ease and enjoyment—helping you feel relaxed and confident beneath the surface. Throughout your dive, you'll be under the close care of our PADI professionals, allowing you to fully immerse yourself in the vibrant beauty of Bawah's coral reefs.

Once you've practiced skills in our swimming pool and feel competent, confident and ready to experience the magic of diving, you will accompany your instructor to one of the beautiful reefs around Bawah Reserve for a fun dive to a depth of no more than 12 metres.

While the Discover Scuba Diving (DSD) experience is not a certification, it does introduce you to key elements of the PADI Open Water course. Should you choose to continue your underwater journey with us, the skills and dive completed during your DSD may be credited towards your PADI certification.

Required for certified divers who haven't been diving for a year or longer, this short course includes a dive theory review, equipment use evaluation and a mini dive in the sheltered waters of Bawah Reserve's lagoon. We review your skills and answer your questions before practising the skills underwater so as to increase your comfort during your future fun dives.

After a discussion about your previous dive experiences with one of our experienced PADI professionals, we design the refresher around you. We tailor it to include aspects of diving that you may have struggled with in the past, so you feel completely confident with us.

While our schedule remains flexible to suit your needs, Scuba Refresher sessions are typically followed by a relaxed fun dive on our vibrant coral reef—an ideal way to put your refreshed skills into practice.

For those who haven't been diving in 5 to 10 years—or longer—we recommend the PADI ReActivate program. This comprehensive refresher revisits the full range of skills from your original Open Water course, ensuring you feel confident and prepared to dive again.

Ideal for both beginners and experienced divers, Fun Diving at Bawah Reserve reflects the resort's relaxed atmosphere. With vibrant shallow reefs, gentle currents, and great visibility year-round, there's something here for everyone. Our reefs are rich with biodiversity—expect sightings of Green and Hawksbill turtles, Bumphead Parrotfish, Blacktip Reef Sharks, Barracuda, Triggerfish, schooling fish (Fusiliers, Trevally, Batfish), Lionfish, Pufferfish, Octopus, Moray eels, nudibranchs, and more.

All of our dive sites are within a 15-minute boat ride on our custom-built dive boats, with water, fruit juice, snacks and towels all provided.

At Bawah Reserve, we strive to make your diving experience as personal and exclusive as possible, with small groups and dedicated dive guides. While we always aim for this, peak times may limit availability. If you'd prefer a fully private experience—with your own boat and guide—we can arrange this for an additional fee.

Travelling with non-divers? They're welcome to join our dive trips and enjoy guided snorkelling at the same beautiful sites for a small extra charge.

To maximise your experience, we recommend pre-booking a 5, 10 or 15-dive package per villa to enjoy preferred rates.

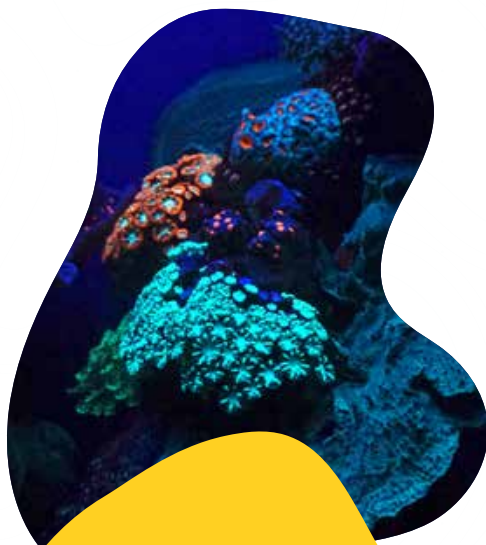

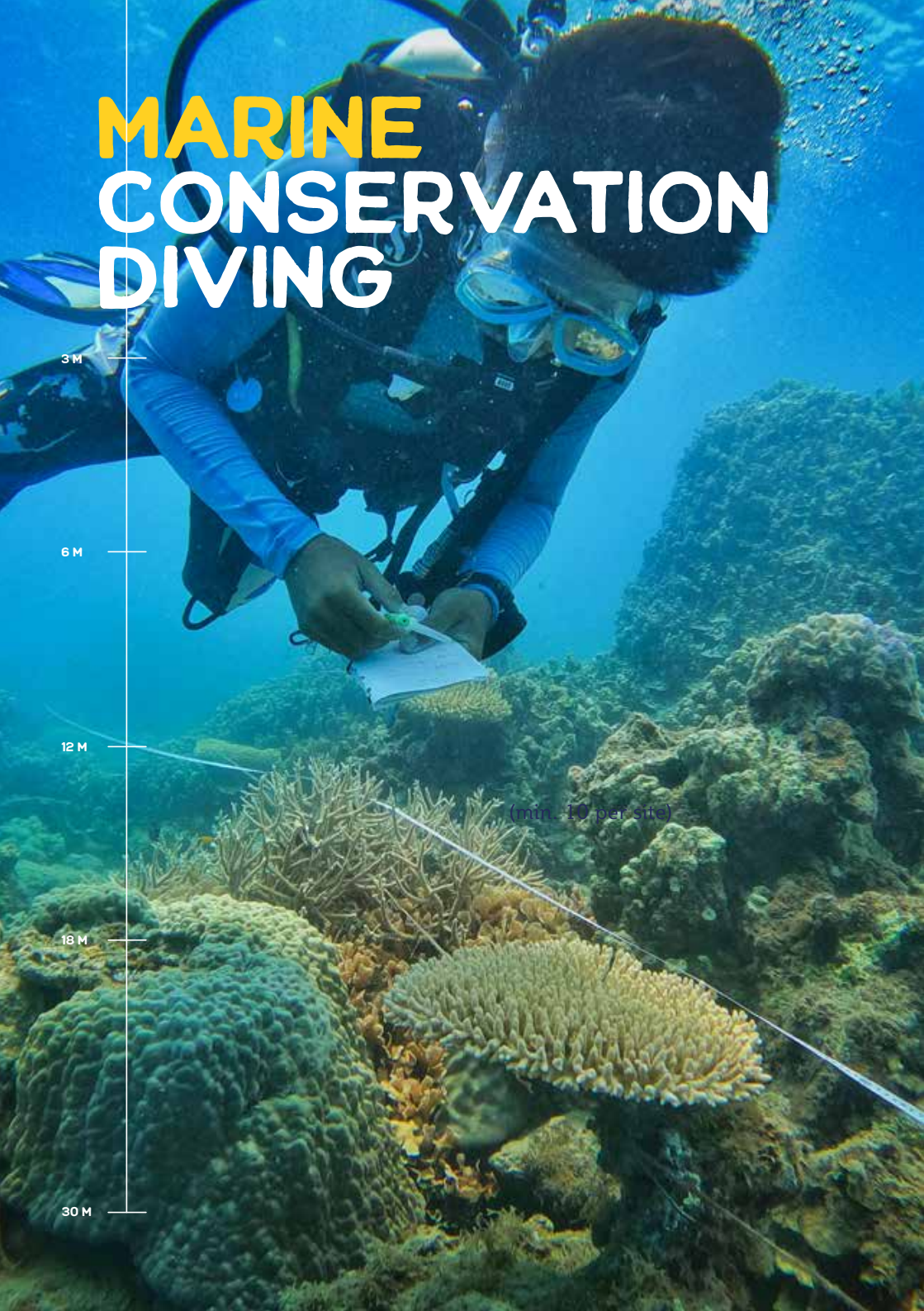

Bawah's Marine Conservation dives offer a new experience for seasoned divers and snorkellers. With coral reefs occupying less than 1% of the world's oceans and being home to over 25% of marine species, their protection is vital to the health of our planet.

The programme allows you an insight into the many Marine Conservation projects championed by Bawah Reserve and gives our team a chance to share our passion with like minded individuals. You gain practical experience in Marine Conservation tasks and all activities are preceded by a 45-minute presentation from one of our qualified marine biologists.

If you are interested in increasing your skills and knowledge further, please consider our 3-day Marine Conservation heroes experiences!

CORAL TRANSPLANTING

Make your dive count! Although the majority of coral reefs surrounding Bawah Reserve are flourishing, a few areas have been affected by decades of unsustainable fishing. Our marine biologists have identified the reefs most in need of repair, and our dive guests are now invited to actively participate in repopulating them with healthy coral fragments from our coral nursery.

REEF HEALTH MONITORING & UNDERWATER CLEAN UP

This educational dive programme is designed to enhance your knowledge of coral reefs while you learn how to help them remain healthy for future generations. You will learn survey techniques and then participate in a survey at one of our seven sites. Once the survey is completed you will use the remainder of the dive to search for and remove man-made debris such as drift nets and plastic items that have floated onto our reefs on water currents.

TURTLE PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

Divers or Snorkellers are welcome to join this project! You will take one of our Diver Propulsion Vehicles (DPVs) and survey the reef for individual turtles. Once found you will skilfully manoeuvre yourself in order to take photos of each side of the turtle's face. The patterns found on a turtle's face are individual to each turtle, so by taking good quality photos of the turtle we will be able to determine if we have seen them on our reefs before!



MARINE CONSERVATION ADOPTION

The underwater world is a marvel of fascinating ecosystems teeming with a rich variety of vibrantly coloured marine plants and sea creatures. At Bawah Reserve, we believe wholeheartedly in marine conservation and are doing all we can to protect the Anambas reefs.

For guests who share our commitment to marine conservation, we offer adoption programmes that give you the opportunity to directly influence and support this work. After leaving Bawah we will provide you with updates on your donation over a suitable period of time.

ADOPT A TURTLE NEST

To protect our local population of turtle nests we patrol and relocate freshly laid eggs in our purpose-built nest enclosure where we can defend them against poachers and other predators. By adopting one of our turtle nests, you will be supporting our efforts to increase the local population of these endangered creatures. We will send you information on the number and species of successful hatchlings, plus photos of the miraculous event.

ADOPT A CORAL TREE FROM OUR NURSERY

Coral trees are safe spaces where threatened coral fragments from our local reefs receive the nutrients they need to grow and thrive. After maturing they are transplanted onto a natural or artificial reef structure by one of our marine conservation divers (that could be you!), where they continue to grow.

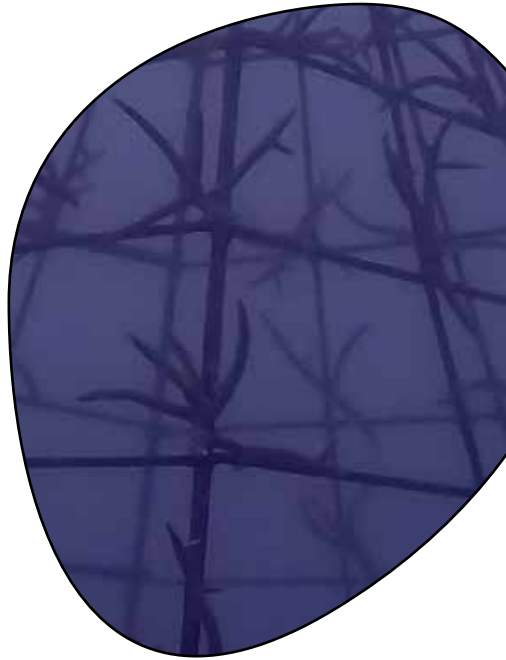


ADOPT AN ARTIFICIAL REEF UNIT

Artificial Reefs are the structures that make coral restoration truly possible. These man-made structures are designed to provide a solid, stable substrate that coral fragments can attach to and grow out from, eventually growing enough to cover the structure and visibly becoming no different to a natural reef.

At Bawah, we have a variety of Artificial Reef sites that you can adopt and support, made of different materials and designs to best suit the topography of the environment they are deployed in. Please discuss with our Marine Conservation team if you are interested in a particular site, otherwise we will be happy to assign you a suitable one.

TURTLE SATELLITE TAGGING

Our marine conservation team has become the first group in the Riau islands to utilise GPS technology to tag and track the movements of endangered hawksbill and green turtles.

This tagging programme allows our marine biologists to monitor the turtles' movements. This could help to identify the key foraging sites of Bawah's sea turtles and the subsequent expansion of Marine Protected Areas to support their continuing conservation.

This project has already started, but still needs support to grow to its full potential. Each donation will support the deployment of a single tag, as the technology is still very expensive.

As an adopter, you would be able to name your turtle, have access to the Argos Satellite System so as to track its movements and be updated on the impact of the research. Just imagine the satisfaction of supporting such a worthwhile project!

CORAL REEF RESTORATION EXPERIENCE



This is a unique opportunity to take part in the renewal of fragile coral ecosystems. After an introductory session on coral health and artificial reef building, you will spend day one creating your own artificial reef unit. On day two, you will dive to collect coral fragments that have naturally broken off. These will be introduced to our reef nurseries for rehabilitation.

The final day culminates with the deployment of your newly created

reef structures, along with the transplanting of nursery-grown corals into damaged reef areas. This immersive experience includes four dives, giving you the chance to make a lasting impact. For a full year, you will receive progress updates on the reefs you helped restore.

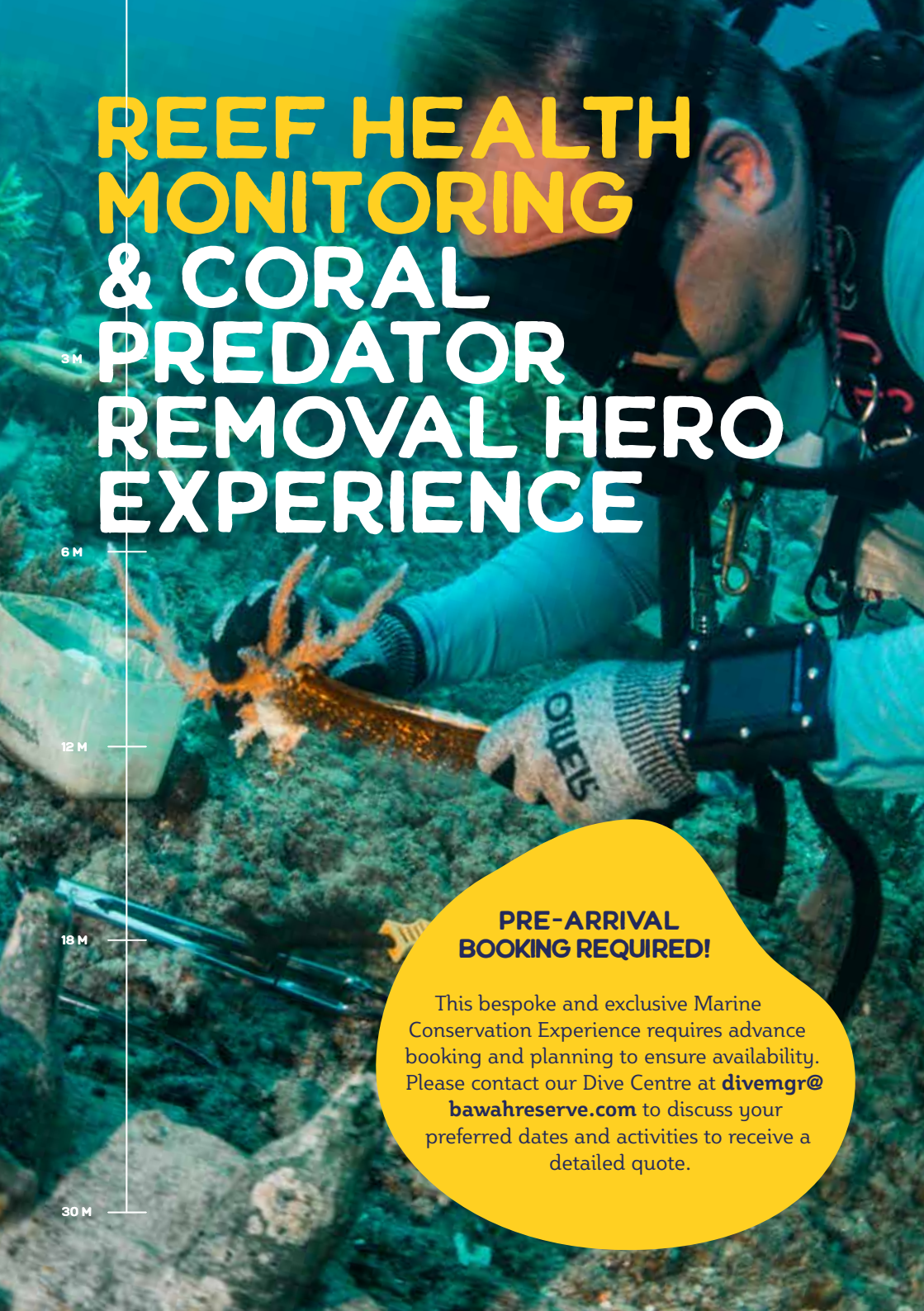

For divers interested in the science of reef preservation, our Reef Health Monitoring and Coral Predator Removal programme offers an in- depth look at coral health and fish biodiversity. By using and understanding scientific survey techniques used commonly throughout Indonesia you will understand how reef health is analysed and how it can influence conservation policy across the country.

This experience begins with a coral health monitoring dive, where participants document the reef through underwater photography. Day two shifts focus to biodiversity, as guests dive to catalogue fish species, followed by an exciting night dive to safely remove the crown of thorns starfish, a known coral predator.

On the final day, you will analyse your collected data with our marine biologists, understanding how they contribute to long-term reef health. This programme includes three dives and is perfect for divers keen on actively protecting Bawah's vibrant reefs.

If you love sea turtles, this experience is a rare opportunity to protect and study these majestic creatures. After an overview of their life cycle and the threats they face, you will join an early morning beach patrol to monitor nesting sites and, if needed, relocate nests to safety. During the day, you will dive or snorkel with Diver Propulsion Vehicles (DPVs) to locate and photograph turtles for identification,

contributing to our ongoing research database. Day two offers another turtle identification dive or snorkel, and an evening beach patrol to observe nesting turtles and assist with data collection. On the final day, you will learn to identify individual turtles using our software, adding your findings to our conservation records.

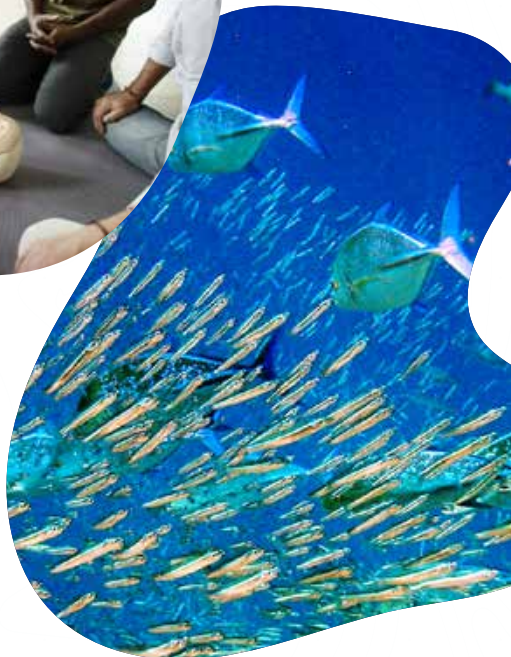
